POSITION SUMMARY:

We are seeking a dedicated Registered Nurse (RN) to join our compassionate healthcare team at our clinic, with a primary focus on serving underrepresented populations. This role involves the collection and assessment of patient data to develop, implement, and evaluate care plans while emphasizing evidence-based practices and addressing the unique healthcare needs of underserved communities. You will actively participate in continuous quality improvement initiatives and take ownership of your professional growth.

SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Record patient histories, conduct diagnostic tests, administer medications, and collaborate with other medical professionals to create patient care plans.
- Assist providers during examinations and procedures, operating and monitoring medical equipment as necessary.
- Evaluate patient responses to care plans, making necessary adjustments in collaboration with the interprofessional team.
- Utilize data to meet care coordination needs across diverse settings, involving patients, families, and other care providers.
- Manage nursing care for individual patients, documenting assessments and interventions.
- Provide safe, ethical, patient- and family-centered, culturally sensitive, and evidence-based care.
- Offer telephone, chart messaging, and in-person triage for symptom management.
- Review and act upon test results within your scope.
- Manage communications from various sources, ensuring timely responses.
- Deliver patient education and support medication management.
- Maintain accurate and timely electronic medical record (EMR) documentation.
- Assist in the management of urgent and emergent patient care situations.
- Work independently within your scope of practice to achieve optimal clinical outcomes.
- Perform any other duties as assigned.
